Childcare Subsidy Application

(Application due January 31st annually)

GSOC-UAW Local 2110 and New York University are pleased to announce a childcare subsidy program has been created for eligible GSOC-UAW graduate employees. The childcare subsidy program is apportioned based upon the number of eligible applicants.

The subsidy is available to those graduate student employees who meet all of the following eligibility criteria:

- Must have held a GSOC-UAW Local 2110 bargaining unit position in calendar year prior to application.
 - For instance, if you are applying during the cycle of applications that is due by January 31st 2025, you must have held a GSOC position during the <u>calendar year 2024</u>.
- Must be a parent or guardian of one or more children.
- Must have expenses associated with the childcare of one or more children.

To apply, please fill out this form and attach:

- 1. a copy of your appointment letter for one semester of work in a Union position in appropriate calendar year;
- 2. proof of birth, such as a copy of your child's birth certificate;
- 3. the attached affidavit, signed, proving your guardianship of the child.

- Graduate students (Master's/Ph.D.) who teach classes or have appointed teaching
 assistantships or laboratory assistantships (except Ph.D. student adjuncts beyond the 7th
 year and MBA candidates at Stern)
- Appointed Ph.D. research assistants (with exceptions at Tandon and GSAS sciences)
- Graduate & Course Assistants (with exceptions at the School of Medicine)
- Graduate student workers in a range of miscellaneous positions, who are employed by NYU
