## International Graduate Employee Accounting and Legal Assistance Fund Application for Academic Year 2021-2022 DUE: January 31, 2023

Effective for the 2021-2022 academic year, a new fund has been established for accounting and legal assistance of international graduate employees. The fund is \$10,000 for the academic year 2021-2022 and is apportioned based upon the number of eligible applicants and the amounts requested.

The subsidy is available to those graduate student employees who meet both eligibility criteria:

- Must have held a GSOC-UAW Local 2110 bargaining unit position during the academic year 2021-2022.
- Must be an international graduate student at NYU.

To apply, please fill out this form and attach:

- 1. A copy of your appointment letter for one semester of work in a bargaining unit position during the academic year 2021-2022;
- 2. A copy of a bill for the accounting or legal services you sought during the academic year 2021-2022; and
- 3. The attached affidavit, signed and notarized, proving your international graduate employee status.

  - **Graduate & Course Assistants** (with exceptions at the School of Medicine)
  - Graduate student workers in a range of miscellaneous positions, who are employed by NYU
